### Guidelines & Tips

**Keep it simple.** Share about topics your student will understand, such as your pets, hobbies, music, sports, activities, favorite scripture verses and your relationship with the Lord. Use this as an opportunity to encourage your student in his or her relationship with the Lord.

**Highlight the things that you might have in common.** As you develop a friendship with your student, you may discover you have a shared interest, such as a passion for sports or an interest in music. Please refrain from discussing your possessions or other things that will call attention to your differences.

**Include a photo of yourself and your family.** Your student will treasure your picture. Due to cultural differences in dress standards, please be sure everyone in the photo is dressed modestly. For example, pool or beach attire would not be appropriate.

We are not able to forward gifts such as jewelry. Items acceptable to include with your letter are photos, postcards, or stickers.
