Six weeks ago, we launched a campaign to respond to the hunger our staff was witnessing in many of the families we serve through Grace Emmanuel School. We have been deeply humbled by your incredible outpouring of love and support. Nearly 100 individuals, families, and churches have responded to give over \$33,000 to provide relief.

As you gave, many of you wrote notes to accompany your gifts. Donations came in from teenagers tithing from summer jobs and families who wanted to give their government relief checks "to our brothers and sisters in need to glorify Jesus, our Lord!" The overarching sentiment was simply expressed in this note: "God has provided abundantly for me and from that grace and joy I want to give to others in need."

JiHM is now well equipped to respond to hunger for the next several months. It is such a relief for our staff to know that as they visit students and families and discover more needs, they can meet them without hesitation.

Our director of operations now reports that families have been physically restored from hunger and are praising God for providing through your generosity. Their neighbors are witnessing genuine love in the name of Jesus as JiHM staff members show up to provide in the midst of a confinement and runaway inflation. Our employee morale is high because your support makes JiHM uniquely able to keep providing jobs when many people are losing paychecks.

JiHM's mission statement begins by declaring that we exist to bring glory to God. God's greatness IS being amplified through Jesus in Haiti Ministries through your consistent prayers, love, and outpouring of concern for your brothers and sisters in Haiti. We can't thank you enough for choosing to be part of this beautiful work.
