### Guidelines & Tips

**Keep it simple.** Share about everyday topics such as your family, pets, jobs, hobbies, music, sports, and activities.

**Encourage faith.** Talk about your favorite Bible stories, your church, and your relationship with the Lord. Share Scripture verses and why they are important to you. Use your letters as an opportunity to encourage your student in his or her relationship with the Lord.

**Ask a question or two.** Find out more about your student's family, friendships, hobbies, and dreams. We recommend limiting the number of questions per letter to one or two.

**Include a photo of yourself and your family.** Your student will treasure your picture. Please be sure everyone in the photo is dressed modestly. **Please staple your photo to the back of the letter.**

We are not able to forward gifts such as jewelry. Items acceptable to include with your letter are photos, postcards, or stickers.
